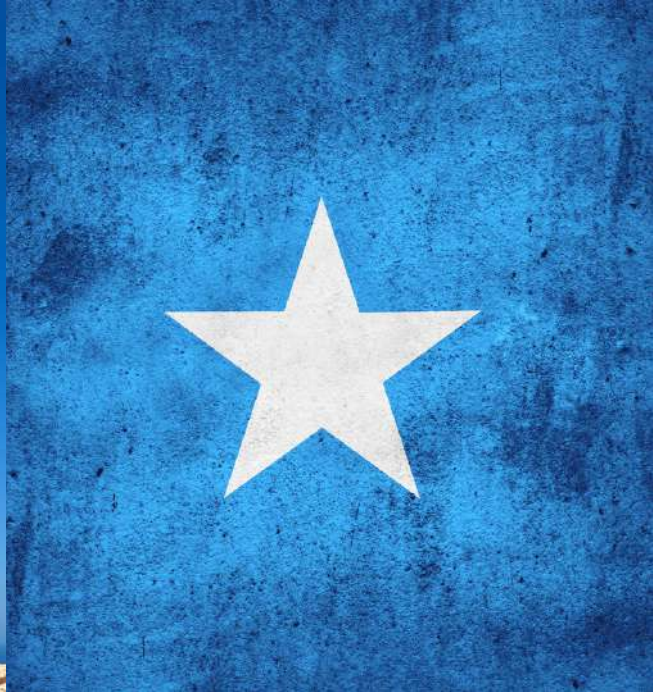

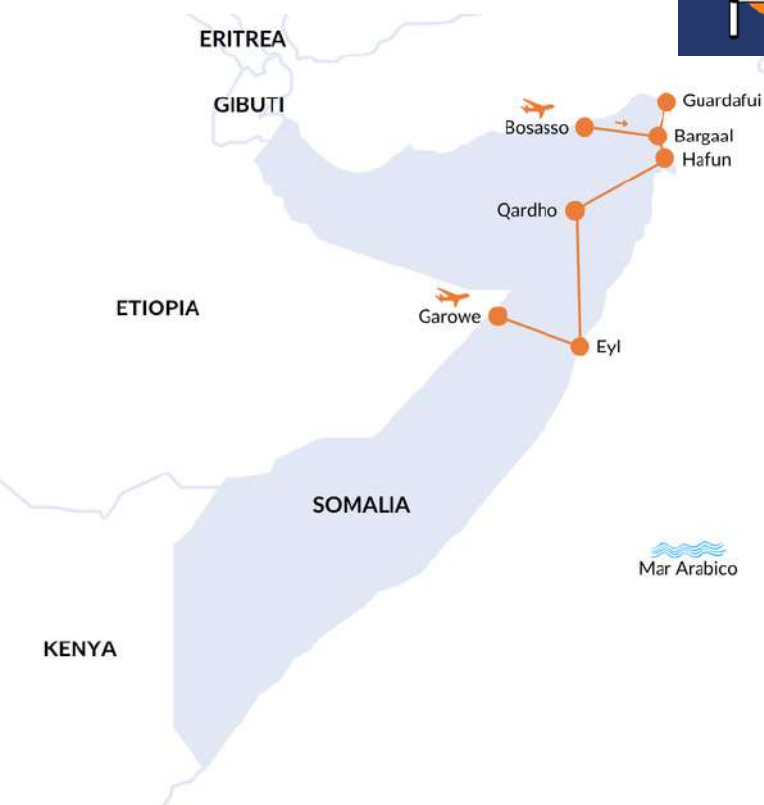

SOMALIA

An expedition into the heart of Puntland, all the way to the legendary Cape Guardafui, where 'Mussolini's lighthouse' stands tall.

From Bosasso to Garowe, via Cape Guardafui and Cape Hafun – the easternmost point of mainland Africa – amongst the remnants of Italy's colonial era in the Horn of Africa, meeting nomadic herders and Somali fishing villages.

A unique journey with the Italian anthropologist Leonardo F. Paoluzzi.

A journey off the beaten track, for true travellers

A trip to Somalia requires strong motivation and a great ability to adapt. The treasures this country holds are not easily accessible; the organisation and logistics are complex, and armed escorts are often required.

There will be long journeys, often over rough tracks; food (special dietary requirements cannot be guaranteed) and accommodation will be whatever is available in these remote areas; you will have to wait patiently at checkpoints and adapt to inevitable changes to the itinerary... In short, an experience for 'true travellers' who are not put off by the complexities of life in Africa, aware that the opportunity to traverse these remote and hard-to-reach lands, whilst interacting with the Somali people, is a privilege reserved for the few – and a precious gift that will certainly make up for the hardships of the journey.

SOMALIA

Day 1: Saturday 28 November 2026

Outward flight (from Europe or Somaliland)

Day 2: Sunday 29 November 2026

Flight/Bosaso (BSA)

Arrival on the Ethiopian Airlines flight at 13:25, completion of formalities and meeting with the Kanaga Africa Tours staff. This is followed by a tour of Bosaso: its markets, the beaches on the Gulf of Aden and the hot springs at Biyo Ukulele. Check-in at the hotel, dinner and overnight stay in a single room with services.

Day 3: Monday 30 November 2026

Bosaso/Bargaal

Early morning breakfast at the hotel. Visit to the bustling fish market in Bosaso, followed by a long day's journey through a rocky desert, encountering Somali nomadic herders. Lunch en route, either from a packed lunch or at a local restaurant. Arrival in Bargaal in the late afternoon and a visit to the ruins of the Majeerteen Sultanate's palace. Check-in at the hotel, dinner and overnight stay in a single room with services.

Day 4: Tuesday 01 December 2027

Bargaal/Cape Gardafui/Bargaal

Breakfast at the hotel. Excursion to Ras Asir (Cape Guardafui) to admire the Italian lighthouse, also known as the 'Mussolini lighthouse', shaped like a fasces. Lunch at a local restaurant. Visit to a fishing village and meeting with the local community (who were once involved in piracy). Return to Bargaal in the afternoon, dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 5: Wednesday 02 December 2026

Bargaal/Hafun

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure for the easternmost point of East Africa, Cape Hafun, where you can admire another lighthouse built by the Italians during the Fascist era. This is followed by a visit to the salt flats and the Italian colonial buildings. Lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, a boat trip to Hurdo to admire Somalia's most beautiful beach, where you can swim in the warm waters of the Indian Ocean. Check-in at the hotel, dinner and overnight stay in a single room with services.

Day 6: Thursday 03 December 2026

Hafun/Qardho

Breakfast at the hotel. Long transfer to the remote inland areas of Puntland. Lunch en route, either a packed lunch or at a local restaurant. On arrival in Qardho, a tour of the town. Check-in at the hotel, dinner and overnight stay in a single room with services.

Day 7: Friday 04 December 2026

Qardho/Eyl

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure for Eyl, Somalia's hidden gem, with its old town and fort, beaches and markets, colonial lighthouse and the military base of the 3rd Italian Battalion. Lunch at a restaurant. In the afternoon, a visit to the fishing village of Badey, where you will learn about traditional fishing techniques. Check-in at the hotel, dinner and overnight stay in a single room with services.

Day 8: Saturday 05 December 2026

Eyl/Garowe

Breakfast at the hotel and the end of the sightseeing tour of Eyl, including its small museum. Transfer to Garowe, with lunch en route (either a packed lunch or at a local restaurant). On arrival, a city tour of this lively town, where you can buy Somali handicrafts. Check-in at the hotel, dinner and overnight stay in a single room with services.

Day 9: Sunday 06 December 2026

Garowe (GGR)/Flight

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit to the bustling livestock market in Garowe, amongst hundreds of animals. Transfer to the airport in good time for the return flight or for the onward flight to Mogadishu.

Day 10: Monday 07 December 2026

Return flight
