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Adventure in the Dzanga Sangha

CAMEROON, CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC

A wild and primordial spot, the Dzanga Sangha Reserve in the Central African Republic covers a triangle of land wedged between the borders of Congo and Cameroon, occupied by intricate primeval nature, criss-crossed by waterways navigable by small wooden boats and inhabited by surprising wildlife.

A perfect destination for eco-tourism circuits, the reserve is the cradle of an explosive nature, inhabited by ancient pygmy peoples, the first to settle in the impenetrable mazes of Central Africa, those mazes that reach as far as the Congo and where Conrad set his Heart of Darkness.

Here, the Baka Pygmies are still the only custodians of the secrets of the forest, moving in symbiosis with the dense equatorial vegetation, between the Lobaye and Sangha-Mbaéré regions. It is therefore not surprising that on the trail of the gorillas, elephants, crocodiles and hippopotamuses that inhabit these green lands, it is the Baka hunters who lead the way, the only ones able to move nimbly in the environment surrounding their camps of huts, knowing how to interpret every slightest sign of nature.

Day 1: Thursday 28 January 2027

Outward flight/Yaoundé (NSI)

Day 2: Friday 29 January 2027

Yaoundé/Bertoua

Markets, Bantu peoples and traces of the German colonial past.

Day 3: Saturday 30 January 2027

Bertoua/Yokadouma

Fishermen on the River Kadey and cocoa plantations.

Day 4: Sunday 31 January 2027

Yokadouma/Libongo/Bayanga

Through the rainforest to the Sangha River, for a boat crossing to Dzanga-Sangha National Park.

Day 5: Monday 1 February 2027

Dzanga-Sangha National Park

Forest trek in search of gorillas.

Day 6: Tuesday 2 February 2027

Dzanga-Sangha National Park

At the Sangha Bai viewing platform, where you can spot forest elephants, bongos and sitatunga antelopes.

Day 7: Wednesday 3 February 2027

Dzanga-Sangha National Park

Pygmy camps in the forest, to discover the secrets of hunting and medicinal plants.

Day 8: Thursday 4 February 2027

Bayanga/Libongo/Yokadouma

Return journey to Cameroon.

Day 9: Friday 5 February 2027

Yokadouma/Bertoua

Colourful markets and artisanal gold mines.



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Day 10: Saturday 6 February 2027

Bertoua/Yaoundé

Arrival in the capital, Yaoundé, with its interesting museums.

Day 11: Sunday 7 February 2027

Yaoundé (NSI)/Return flight
