### The 'unforgettable' of the trip:



- The old slave house on **Gorée Island**, testimony to a horrible past
- The **pink lake**, final stage of the legendary Paris-Dakar rally
- The **ornithological park of Djoudj**, a birdwatching paradise
- The colonial town of **Saint-Louis**, to be discovered on a slow horse-drawn carriage ride
- The lush landscapes of **Lower Casamance**
- The dilapidated colonial buildings of **Ziguinchor** and **Carabane**
- **Banjul**, the capital of Africa's smallest state
- Dugout canoe trip through the mangroves of **Siné-Saloum**



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**Lush landscapes, traditional villages and heavenly beaches. Casamance, the southernmost tip of Senegal, is the ideal destination for combining tranquil beach holidays and exciting excursions in a wild and secluded environment. A tropical paradise for those who wish to approach the magic and charms of Black Africa without filters.**

A tour that starts from the highlights of classic Senegal: Gorée, Lake Rosa, Lompoul, Saint Louis, Touba and Siné-Saloum, to reach the country's greenest and most unspoilt area, Casamance, a long strip of land squeezed between Gambia and the forests of Guinea Bissau, the rushing waters of the Atlantic Ocean and the scorching savannahs of the Sahel. A natural sanctuary of extraordinary beauty amidst villages that are small traditional monarchies with kings and notables, mangrove canyons and labyrinths of rivers and still waters around which palm trees and thatched-roof huts peep. Here it is possible to immerse oneself in the life of the Diola, a people who have jealously preserved the customs and traditions of the animist tradition, proudly rejecting all attempts at Islamisation, remaining faithful to the spirits of the forest.

### Itinerario

Day 1: Wednesday 31 March 2027

**Outward flight/ Dakar (DSS)/Pink Lake**

Day 2: Thursday 1 April 2027

**Pink Lake/Gorée Island/Pink Lake**

The pastel-coloured colonial buildings and the House of Slaves on Gorée Island.

Day 3: Friday 2 April 2027

**Pink Lake/Lompoul/Saint-Louis**

The pink waters of Lake Retba, the final stage of the Paris-Dakar Rally, and the dunes of the Lompoul Desert.

Day 4: Saturday 3 April 2027

**Saint-Louis/Djoudj/Saint-Louis**

The Djoudj Bird Sanctuary and the colonial town of Saint-Louis, with its picturesque fishermen's quarter.

Day 5: Sunday 4 April 2027

**Saint-Louis/Touba/Kaolack**

The great Mouride mosque in Touba and the fruit and vegetable market in Kaolack.

Day 6: Monday 5 April 2027

**Kaolack/Gambia/Ziguinchor**

Crossing the Gambia to reach the lush Casamance region.

Day 7: Tuesday 6 April 2027

**Ziguinchor/Carabane/Oussouye/Ziguinchor**

The colonial island of Carabane and the meeting with the King of Oussouye in the sacred forest.

Day 8: Wednesday 7 April 2027

**Ziguinchor/Banjul**

The capital of The Gambia, with its markets, fishing villages, sacred caimans and beaches.

Day 9: Thursday 8 April 2027

**Banjul/Toubacouta**

The Siné-Saloum Delta: a pirogue trip through the mangroves.



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Day 10: Friday 9 April 2027

**Toubacouta/Joal Fadiouth/Somone**

The shell island of Fadiouth and the beaches of the Petite Côte.

Day 11: Saturday 10 April 2027

**Somone/Bandia/Mbour/Dakar (DSS)**

Safari in the Bandia Reserve and the landscapes of Somone, between the lagoon and the ocean.

Day 12: Sunday 11 April 2027

**Dakar (DSS)/Return flight**
