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There are countless adventures and landscapes that enchant and thrill travellers in this extraordinary, arid and desert-like land – seemingly inhospitable – which stretches across endless savannahs and expanses of sand in shades of red as fiery as the flames.

As you leave the modern capital, the landscapes gradually give way to increasingly arid areas, vast lands where little or nothing grows and where animal species have developed the ability to adapt to virtually non-existent vegetation. Etosha National Park and the rocky hills of Damaraland offer the most thrilling wildlife sightings, with a miraculous abundance of 'desert elephants', cheetahs, lions, rhinos, antelopes, giraffes and numerous other species populating these surreal landscapes, rich in mineral salts within the vast salt pans.

But the thrill in Namibia is ever-present, from the barren ridges of the Kaokoland massif, where Himba women dye their long hair and skin orange with a mixture of fat, herbs and ochre—the same colour that tints the majestic dunes of the world's oldest desert—the Namib, which flows directly into the ocean, carving a path through the endless sand dune of Sossusvlei, the petrified acacias and the thermal mist that envelops everything, allowing the beautiful oryx to survive, in one of the world's most evocative spectacles. A contrast of colours and scenery everywhere, from the ghostly shipwrecks of the Skeleton Coast to the town of Swakopmund and Walvis Bay, where the sociable and friendly sea lions rush onto the beach to greet visitors.

Night safari for the first wildlife sightings.

Day 3: Thursday 22 April 2027

Okonjima Nature Reserve/Etosha National Park

Encounter with cheetahs at Okonjima before a safari in Etosha.

Day 4: Friday 23 April 2027

Etosha National Park

Thrilling safaris amongst big cats, rhinos and elephants.

Day 5: Saturday 24 April 2027

Etosha/Kamanjab/Palmwag

A fascinating encounter with the Himba people.

Day 6: Sunday 25 April 2027

Palmwag/Twyfelfontein

On the trail of rhinos in the Torra Conservancy, before exploring the rock engravings of Damaraland.

Day 7: Monday 26 April 2027

Twyfelfontein/Brandberg

A trek to see the rock paintings of the 'White Lady' at Brandberg.



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Day 8: Tuesday 27 April 2027

Brandberg/Cape Cross/Swakopmund

The Cape Cross sea lions, the Zeila shipwreck and the German colonial architecture in Swakopmund.

Day 9: Wednesday 28 April 2027

Swakopmund/Walvis Bay/Sandwich Harbour/Swakopmund

A boat trip in search of dolphins and flamingos, before arriving at Sandwich Harbour, where the desert meets the ocean.

Day 10: Thursday 29 April 2027

Swakopmund/Solitaire/Sossusvlei

The iconic Solitaire petrol station and the Namib dunes on the horizon.

Day 11: Friday 30 April 2027

Namib Desert

Amidst the majestic 'Big Daddy' dunes, the surreal landscapes of Deadvlei, and the Sesriem Canyon.

Day 12: Saturday 1 May 2027

Sossusvlei/Windhhoek (WDH)/Return flight

Return to the city and city tour.
